A.C.C. Approval

Any Resident planning to change the exterior of their property must obtain approval from the A.C.C. Chairman. North Strabane Township will not issue a building permit to any resident of Glencannon unless they have this approval from the association. Approval must be obtained for decks, doors, windows, sidewalks, patios, sheds, painting, etc.

A \$50 fine may be assessed for failure to submit the ACC form with proper approval.

Selling Your Property?

If you are planning to sell your property you will need a "Resale Certificate" signed by a GHA Board Member and the GHA Secretary. The Resale Certificate is issued when all GHA dues and assessments have been received by GHA resulting in a zero balance owed. The Resale Certificate is required for your home Closing.

As a reminder under Act 180, the Association has ten days to provide the Resale Certificate and other items to the seller. Please contact the GHA Secretary as soon as possible so that your Resale Certificate can be prepared.

There is a fee of \$75 for a Resale Certificate.

Attorney Fee Policy

Residents who fail to pay the monthly \$43 assessment for five months or more can expect an official warning letter from Glencannon Homes Association. Failure to respond will result in a letter from the Glencannon Attorney and a \$100 letter drafting fee will be added to the amount owed. Homeowners that force the Attorney file a lien on their property (for lack of payment) will also have those fees added to their account.

Dog Laws

Please remember that Pennsylvania and the township of North Strabane have laws pertaining to DOGS.

Pennsylvania State Law: All dogs must be under control and may not be allowed to run at large. Dogs are personal property and owners are responsible for damages caused by their dogs. This means that when your dog is not on your property, it must be under direct control of you or a handler. The best way to control your dog is with a leash.

North Strabane Township Ordinance:

It shall be unlawful for the owner of any dog or dogs to allow or permit such dog or dogs to run at large in the township of North Strabane.

> We ask that all residents please clean up after your pets. Thank you for your cooperation.

Glencannon ACC regulations require that GARBAGE CONTAINERS are to be stored indoors or inconspicuously outdoors (not in front of your residence).

Garbage containers should be placed at the curb no earlier than 5:00 p.m. the night before collection day, and must be removed

the next day.

Glencannon Homes Association March 16, 2021 Monthly Meeting of the Directors

Mr. Creighan called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm.

ROLL CALL

Terry Creighan – President, Shawn Beard – Vice President, Jim Byer, Doug Krantz. Dave Wheeler, John Ackerman, and Gretchen Gregorchik not present and excused.

FINANCIALS

The board discussed the financial reports that were distributed for February 2021. Mr. Krantz made a motion to approve. Mr. Beard seconded the motion. Vote: Mr. Creighan – yes, Mr. Byer – yes.

COMMONS

The board discussed gathering bids for the fencing along the pool walkway. There were 7 companies contacted and 1 came to look at the area today and will submit a bid. The fencing along playground A was discussed and needs replaced. The work needed will be considered in the fencing bid for the walkway. [Note: The contractor called and stated they will not bid the project due to materials shortages.]

The beds were discussed and the work that was done last year by MJ Donas. They were contacted again to submit their bid for the 2021 season. Once their bid is obtained, it will be sent to each board member for review.

The snow removal in the winter was discussed and considering a separate contractor to do

snow removal as needed. This will be considered when the Landscaping Contract is renewed.

The fire bushes on Hunting Creek were discussed and some need replaced. Cramer Landscaping will be notified about this.

ACC

There was one ACC request over the last few months which was approved.

REC

A bid was distributed to refurbish the baby pool; the wall (with cherubs) needs to be replaced, a new one will be constructed and have smooth tile and a water ledge feature. The floor surface needs replaced to avoid maintenance and yearly painting. Some of the block wall needs re-set and coated and the concrete around the baby pool needs addressed. The board also discussed that the surface area under the pavilion will be considered in the bid as well.

OLD BUSINESS

The pond work was discussed and the last update from the Harshman CE Group. The final permits are being obtained and the bid work will begin. The aerator will be installed in the pond in April.

OPEN DISCUSSION

A resident was present and discussed with the board about the paving to be done with her and her neighbors and their shared driveway on Meadowview Drive. They are obtaining bids and receiving commitments from several of the neighbors. The resident present will work with the office to notify the neighbors that have not agreed or were not able to be contacted.



Attention Landlords!

- The monthly payment of \$43 is due the first of the month. Owners have ultimate responsibility, if tenants are asked to pay the dues on their own; fees will be added to the owners account for non-payment.
- Garbage pick-up is on Mondays and refuse should be on the curb the night before (with the exception of Memorial Day and Labor Day, collection is pushed back a day).
- The property should be maintained, grass cut, bushes trimmed and toys should not be left for days on end.
- Clean-up after your pets.
- Vehicles are not to be parked on common grounds grassy areas.
- Noise levels should be kept to a minimum.

Plastic bags are <u>NOT</u> to be included in your recycling container.

In addition, glass is no longer acceptable because it can break and contaminate other recyclable items.

Notice:

Vehicles without current registration stickers are **not** permitted to be parked in Glencannon commons parking pads. In addition, vehicles parked in commons parking for long periods of time will be researched for resident ownership.
