

A.C.C. Approval

Any Resident planning to change the exterior of their property must obtain approval from the A.C.C. Chairman. North Strabane Township will not issue a building permit to any resident of Glencannon unless they have this approval from the association. Approval must be obtained for decks, doors, windows, sidewalks, patios, sheds, painting, etc.

A \$50 fine may be assessed for failure to submit the ACC form with proper approval.

Selling Your Property?

If you are planning to sell your property you will need a "Resale Certificate" signed by a GHA Board Member and the GHA Secretary. The Resale Certificate is issued when all GHA dues and assessments have been received by GHA resulting in a zero balance owed. The Resale Certificate is required for your home Closing.

As a reminder under Act 180, the Association has ten days to provide the Resale Certificate and other items to the seller. Please contact the GHA Secretary as soon as possible so that your Resale Certificate can be prepared.

There is a fee of \$75 for a Resale Certificate.

Attorney Fee Policy

Residents who fail to pay the monthly \$43 assessment for five months or more can expect an official warning letter from Glencannon Homes Association. Failure to respond will result in a letter from the Glencannon Attorney and a \$100 letter drafting fee will be added to the amount owed. Homeowners that force the Attorney file a lien on their property (for lack of payment) will also have those fees added to their account.

Glencannon Homes Association has several major expenses: Pond Maintenance, Common Ground Maintenance, the pool complex, electricity (street lights) and garbage pick-up is also included.

In addition, there are other expenses like: Insurance coverage, legal fees, yearly audit, newsletter/website, payroll (Secretary, Pool Manager and Guards) and events (like the Easter Egg Hunt).

A budget is posted every year and a monthly financial report is published in every newsletter.

How is the pond project coming along and when can we expect work to begin?

Our hired engineering company has plans drawn up for refurbishing the pond, however, we are awaiting the DEP to review and approve the plans.

Considering the backlog of work for the DEP, this could take a while. We will post in this newsletter as soon as we hear something.

Mr. Creighan called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm.

FINANCIALS

The board reviewed the financial packets and discussed the AR list. A settlement agreement for one of the residents was discussed and the report from the attorney. Mr. Byer made a motion to approve the financial reports for June 2017. Mr. Beard seconded the motion. Vote: Mr. Creighan – yes, Ms. Manolas – yes, Mr. Frohnaphel, Jr. – yes, Mr. Ackerman – yes, Mr. Chirdon – yes.

ACC

The board discussed a shed and a deck in the neighborhood and whether an ACC request was submitted. The change in township ordinances was also discussed as it applies to decks.

REC

Everything is running as normal. The lifeguard schedule is done until the end of the month. The resurfacing of the tennis court was discussed and someone is needed to oversee the bid process. There have been contractors that have looked at it but no formal bid has been obtained. Discussion occurred about what is needed for the area and timeframes that are necessary.

COMMONS

The garbage cans have not been emptied and some of the grass cutting has not been done.

The landscapers have been notified about this. In addition, the bench was ordered for the bed on Old Meadow and will be delivered soon. The details of the delivery were discussed as well as putting it together. The Hope Committee chair said her and another resident purchased terra cotta planters for the bed on 19 with flowers. The planters were stolen.

NEW BUSINESS

The secretary will be on vacation for a few days at the end of the month. The phone and the email will be covered by other board members. The mailboxes and cluster boxes were discussed on Meadowview Drive.

OLD BUSINESS

The board discussed lien letters that were sent as well as people that have not maintained their payment arrangements. Additional title searches will be done and the foreclosure process explored for residents that are significantly delinquent.

Dog Laws

Please remember that Pennsylvania and the township of North Strabane have laws pertaining to DOGS.

Pennsylvania State Law: All dogs must be under control and may not be allowed to run at large. Dogs are personal property and owners are responsible for damages caused by their dogs. This means that when your dog is not on your property, it must be under direct control of you or a handler. The best way to control your dog is with a leash.

North Strabane Township Ordinance:

It shall be unlawful for the owner of any dog or dogs to allow or permit such dog or dogs to run at large in the township of North Strabane.

We ask that all residents please leash your dog and clean up after them. Thank you for your cooperation.
