## A.C.C. Approval

Any Resident planning to change the exterior of their property must obtain approval from the A.C.C. Chairman. North Strabane Township will not issue a building permit to any resident of Glencannon unless they have this approval from the association. Approval must be obtained for decks, doors, windows, sidewalks, patios, sheds, painting, etc.

A \$50 fine may be assessed for failure to submit the ACC form with proper approval.

## Selling Your Property?

If you are planning to sell your property you will need a "Resale Certificate" signed by a GHA Board Member and the GHA Secretary. The Resale Certificate is issued when all GHA dues and assessments have been received by GHA resulting in a zero balance owed. The Resale Certificate is required for your home Closing.

As a reminder under Act 180, the Association has ten days to provide the Resale Certificate and other items to the seller. Please contact the GHA Secretary as soon as possible so that your Resale Certificate can be prepared.

There is a fee of \$75 for a Resale Certificate.

## Attorney Fee Policy

Residents who fail to pay the monthly \$43 assessment for five months or more can expect an official warning letter from Glencannon Homes Association. Failure to respond will result in a letter from the Glencannon Attorney and a \$100 letter drafting fee will be added to the amount owed. Homeowners that force the Attorney file a lien on their property (for lack of payment) will also have those fees added to their account.

#### COMMONS

The board discussed issues with tree limbs and what needs trimmed. The details of the work with Cramer Landscaping were discussed as well.

There are some repairs that are needed in the pool area which will be completed in the next few weeks.

There were 3 requests over the last month. The board is reviewing the requests for approval.

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#### **OLD BUSINESS**

#### **OPEN DISCUSSION**

A resident was present to discuss the broken Verizon boxes in the common area behind the pool house. The board discussed with her that Verizon will be notified about this.

Two residents were present to discuss changes she would like to see happen in the future at the rec center. They provided ideas about adding stairs from the pool parking lot directly down to the pavilion. Also, she suggested removing the tennis court and adding another pavilion.

Another resident was present to discuss the dumpster between the condos and the apartments. The area needs repaired and the asphalt replaced. The board discussed with him what needs done to obtain the bids and to get the work done.

A resident was present and distributed a handout about flowers that she would like for various beds in the community.

Meeting adjourned at 8:00pm.

#### **Executive Meeting**

The board met in executive session following the regular meeting and discussed the future of the Landscaping (H.O.P.E.) committee. The board voted unanimously to eliminate the committee. It was determined that any resident who would like to make landscaping requests can come to the board with their ideas. This information will be posted in the newsletter for August. A long time resident of Glencannon is starting a social group for senior citizens in the neighborhood! The group will meet at Kings on the 3rd Wednesday of each month starting September 19, 2018 at 1:00 pm.

## Dog Laws

Please remember that Pennsylvania and the township of North Strabane have laws pertaining to DOGS. Pennsylvania State Law: All dogs must be under control and may not be allowed to run at large. Dogs are personal property and owners are responsible for damages caused by their dogs. This means that when your dog is not on your property, it must be under direct control of you or a handler. The best way to control your dog is with a leash.

#### North Strabane Township Ordinance:

It shall be unlawful for the owner of any dog or dogs to allow or permit such dog or dogs to run at large in the township of North Strabane. *We ask that all residents please leash* your dog and clean up after them. Thank you for your cooperation.

The following items are strictly prohibited.

- Televisions

- Car batteries
- Oil, gas or hazardous liquids

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## Glencannon Pond Repairs – Project Status Update

#### Permit Applications:

a) NPDES (National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System) Permit – The Washington County Conservation District Comments have been addressed, but we are working on addressing the DEP comments sent at a later date prior to a resubmittal. We have been in contact with them and have requested an extension in order to allow us time to address the DEP comments.

**b)** Chapter 105 Dam Amendment/Authorization Letter – we have received comments back from the DEP Dam Safety Department which we are currently working on addressing. One of the comments requires a revised check payable to the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania Clean Water Fund.

**c)** General Permit 7 (GP-7) – The GP-7 permit has been prepared and will be submitted to the Washington County Conservation District along side the revisions to the NPDES permit submission.

**d)** Township Grading Permit – to be prepared after DEP's first round of technical comments have been addressed.
