A.C.C. Approval

Any Resident planning to change the exterior of their property must obtain approval from the A.C.C. Chairman. North Strabane Township will not issue a building permit to any resident of Glencannon unless they have this approval from the association. Approval must be obtained for decks, doors, windows, sidewalks, patios, sheds, painting, etc.

A \$50 fine may be assessed for failure to submit the ACC form with proper approval.

Selling Your Property?

If you are planning to sell your property you will need a "Resale Certificate" signed by a GHA Board Member and the GHA Secretary. The Resale Certificate is issued when all GHA dues and assessments have been received by GHA resulting in a zero balance owed. The Resale Certificate is required for your home Closing.

As a reminder under Act 180, the Association has ten days to provide the Resale Certificate and other items to the seller. Please contact the GHA Secretary as soon as possible so that your Resale Certificate can be prepared.

There is a fee of \$75 for a Resale Certificate.

Attorney Fee Policy

Residents who fail to pay the monthly \$43 assessment for five months or more can expect an official warning letter from Glencannon Homes Association. Failure to respond will result in a letter from the Glencannon Attorney and a \$100 letter drafting fee will be added to the amount owed. Homeowners that force the Attorney file a lien on their property (for lack of payment) will also have those fees added to their account.

Dog Laws

Please remember that Pennsylvania and the township of North Strabane have laws pertaining to DOGS.

Pennsylvania State Law: All dogs must be under control and may not be allowed to run at large. Dogs are personal property and owners are responsible for damages caused by their dogs. This means that when your dog is not on your property, it must be under direct control of you or a handler. The best way to control your dog is with a leash.

North Strabane Township Ordinance:

It shall be unlawful for the owner of any dog or dogs to allow or permit such dog or dogs to run at large in the township of North Strabane.

We ask that all residents please clean up after your pets. Thank you for your cooperation.





Glencannon ACC regulations require that GARBAGE CONTAINERS are to be stored indoors or inconspicuously outdoors (not in front of your residence).

Garbage containers should be placed at the curb no earlier than 5:00 p.m. the night before collection day, and must be removed the next day.

Mr Krantz called the meeting to order at 6:30pm

Roll Call

Doug Krantz – President, John Ackerman, Terry Creighan, Gretchen Gregorchik and Dave Wheeler. Shawn Beard – not present and excused.

Financials

The financials reports were reviewed which were distributed last week. The vote will occur at the next meeting.

Commons

The board discussed the landscaping work that needs done including tall weeds by the pool house and other maintenance that needs addressed.

Installing the pond aerator was also discussed which was put on hold until clarification was received about the pond work. Mr. Creighan volunteered to put it in within the next few weeks.

Rec

The current pool season is going well with no major issues. The pool manager with American Pools has done a great job this season. Three tables were replaced. Two were broken this year and one last year. The board discussed compensating a resident \$25 for picking up and delivering the tables after they were ordered last month.

The board also discussed that there are residents not following the rule of no alcohol at the pool. The board discussed putting another separate notice in the newsletter and posting a sign at the pool.

New Business

The board discussed the issues that occurred over the last month with a possible Airbnb in the community. The GHA attorney was consulted and clarified that this is not permitted due to interpretation of the bylaws and the township ordinances. The resident was notified of this.

The lights on upper Hunting Creek were discussed and the board will be getting the prices and information to transition them to solar.

Mr. Creighan made a motion to adjourn and Mrs. Gregorchik seconded. Meeting adjourned at 7pm

Financials

The financial reports were discussed at the executive meeting and Mr. Creighan made a motion to approve. Mrs. Gregorchik seconded the motion. Vote: Mr. Ackerman – yes, Mr. Krantz – yes and Mr. Wheeler – yes.

Commons

The board will continue to look for areas in need of attention to report to the landscapers.

Rec

The pool is running well and there have been all positive reports about the staff from American Pools including the head guard, Lydia and the rest of the lifeguards. There were 3 tables purchased over the last month.

ACC

There were multiple requests over the last month and all were approved.

New Business

The board discussed the reports that are made by residents regarding disputes with neighbors. In addition, there continues to be reports about teenagers being out late at night. The residents making these reports will continue to be told that this is a police matter and to notify North Strabane Police Department.

Open Discussion

Two residents were present at the meeting. The board discussed with them the status of the pond project and that one bid was obtained for the work after the ad was place by Harshman CE Group. In an attempt to get more than one bid, additional advertising was done covering a wider area on June 24, 2022. The deadline to submit the bid is July 23, 2022.

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Questions of the Month

I heard that we have a bid for the pond project. Haven't we waited long enough? Why aren't we accepting the bid?

As of Wednesday, July 27th there has been one bid received. We extended until Friday, July 29th so that some Contractors that expressed interest can get the paperwork in. The Board has a policy of obtaining at least three bids for expenditures in excess of \$250.00. It would not be fiscally responsible to spend a large amount without adequate comparisons simply because "we have waited long enough" for the updated pond. Please feel free to join as a Board Member to help us move the project along and get first hand knowledge of everything that is involved in making this dream a reality.

Why have the food trucks canceled? I decided not to make dinner expecting the food truck.

Please know that it takes effort to find food trucks to schedule with. The Board thought that having food trucks would be a good way to have fun and get the community together. However, after receiving negative feedback about food trucks canceling at the last minute (due to labor shortages which is a nationwide phenomenon), the Board will no longer spend their time scheduling. We understand that it is inconvenient to plan around a food truck that does not show as planned, but back up plans should be made.
