A.C.C. Approval

Any Resident planning to change the exterior of their property must obtain approval from the A.C.C. Chairman. North Strabane Township will not issue a building permit to any resident of Glencannon unless they have this approval from the association. Approval must be obtained for decks, doors, windows, sidewalks, patios, sheds, painting, etc.

A \$50 fine may be assessed for failure to submit the ACC form with proper approval.

Selling Your Property?

If you are planning to sell your property you will need a "Resale Certificate" signed by a GHA Board Member and the GHA Secretary. The Resale Certificate is issued when all GHA dues and assessments have been received by GHA resulting in a zero balance owed. The Resale Certificate is required for your home Closing.

As a reminder under Act 180, the Association has ten days to provide the Resale Certificate and other items to the seller. Please contact the GHA Secretary as soon as possible so that your Resale Certificate can be prepared.

There is a fee of \$75 for a Resale Certificate.

Attorney Fee Policy

Residents who fail to pay the monthly \$43 assessment for five months or more can expect an official warning letter from Glencannon Homes Association. Failure to respond will result in a letter from the Glencannon Attorney and a \$100 letter drafting fee will be added to the amount owed. Homeowners that force the Attorney file a lien on their property (for lack of payment) will also have those fees added to their account.

Dave Wheeler and Rebecca Ware not present and excused.

Mr. Creighan called the meeting to order at 6:30 pm.

FINANCIALS

The board discussed the financial reports that were distributed over the last week. The AR list was discussed and additional title searches will be done on several properties that are delinquent. The foreclosure process will begin for several residents, additional liens are being filed as well.

COMMONS

The board discussed the work being done by Cramer Landscaping; they were notified of the need to pick up all of the branches and trash removal after they were here this week.

The board also discussed the bid process for the 2020-2021 landscaping contract. Several companies have expressed interest and a tour of the community to prepare a bid. The board discussed separating the bid into several different responsibilities. Once they are all submitted, the board will review and vote.

The pond status was discussed including the placement of the dredge once the work begins. The permit process was reviewed as well and some changes that have occurred with the DEP. The status update from the engineers was submitted to the board for review.

REC

The board discussed that Mr. Miele is moving and will not be available to do the work he has done in the community over the past several years. They discussed that an ad will be put in the newsletter to find someone who would be interested in taking over his duties. In the past, Mr. Miele has done maintenance at the pool, with the lights at the pond and various other tasks.

OLD BUSINESS

County Hauling has taken over the garbage contract. The transition had minor issues and was quick to address them.

The details of aesthetic items for the pond as part of the renovation were reviewed. It was discussed that this will be determined in the final bid process.

FINANCIALS

The board discussed the details of the financial reports at the executive meeting so Mr. Byer made a motion to approve the reports and Mr. Beard seconded the motion. Vote: Mr. Creighan – yes, Mr. Sacco – Yes, Mr. Krantz– yes and Mr. Ackerman – no.

ACC

The ACC Chair discussed that there were two requests submitted. One was approved and the other is approved pending township approval.

OLD BUSINESS

It was discussed that the playgrounds swings are replaced. Additional chains will be purchased for Playground A. The painting project was completed in the fall.

NEW BUSINESS

A board member present discussed that he believes he is not getting all of the emails that are being sent by the board. The board discussed this with him. In addition, he stated that several residents have contacted him about starting an ethics committee and would like to look into the board. He said he was only serving as a liaison and has not determined if he wants to be on the committee.

OPEN DISCUSSION

No resident comments.

Meeting Adjourned at 7:15pm

Glencannon ACC regulations require that GARBAGE CONTAINERS are to be stored indoors or inconspicuously outdoors (not in front of your residence).

Garbage containers should be placed at the curb **no earlier than 5:00 p.m. the night before collection day,** and must be removed the next day.

Attention Landlords!

You are responsible for informing your tenants the following information

- The monthly payment of \$43 is due the first of the month. Owners have ultimate responsibility, if tenants are asked to pay the dues on their own; fees will be added to the <u>owners</u> account for non-payment.
- Garbage pick-up is on Wednesdays and refuse should be on the curb the night before (with the exception of holiday weeks that are pushed back a day).
- The property should be maintained, grass cut, bushes trimmed and toys should not be left for days on end.
- Clean-up after your pets.
- Vehicles are not to be parked on common grounds grassy areas.
- Noise levels should be kept to a minimum.

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Dog Laws

Please remember that Pennsylvania and the township of North Strabane have laws pertaining to DOGS.

Pennsylvania State Law: All dogs must be under control and may not be allowed to run at large. Dogs are personal property and owners are responsible for damages caused by their dogs. This means that when your dog is not on your property, it must be under direct control of you or a handler. The best way to control your dog is with a leash.

North Strabane Township Ordinance:

It shall be unlawful for the owner of any dog or dogs to allow or permit such dog or dogs to run at large in the township of North Strabane.

We ask that all residents please clean up after your pets. Thank you for your cooperation.

Annual Statements

Every GHA Homeowner receives a statement by mid-February to verify payment status.

This is necessary for paperwork purposes and it helps residents that may be unaware of their current balance.

NOTICE:

Vehicles without current registration stickers are not permitted to be parked in Glencannon commons parking pads. In addition, vehicles parked in commons parking for long periods of time will be researched for resident ownership.

These vehicles will be towed at the owners expense.

Lamppost Alert

GHA has noticed several lampposts that have been burned-out for a long period of time, these properties will be sent a letter informing them to have the post repaired.

These lampposts provide most of the lighting on our streets which is essential for safety and helps to curb vandalism.
