A.C.C. Approval

Any Resident planning to change the exterior of their property must obtain approval from the A.C.C. Chairman. North Strabane Township will not issue a building permit to any resident of Glencannon unless they have this approval from the association. Approval must be obtained for decks, doors, windows, sidewalks, patios, sheds, painting, etc.

A \$50 fine may be assessed for failure to submit the ACC form with proper approval.

Selling Your Property?

If you are planning to sell your property you will need a "Resale Certificate" signed by a GHA Board Member and the GHA Secretary. The Resale Certificate is issued when all GHA dues and assessments have been received by GHA resulting in a zero balance owed. The Resale Certificate is required for your home Closing.

As a reminder under Act 180, the Association has ten days to provide the Resale Certificate and other items to the seller. Please contact the GHA Secretary as soon as possible so that your Resale Certificate can be prepared.

There is a fee of \$75 for a Resale Certificate.

Attorney Fee Policy

Residents who fail to pay the monthly \$43 assessment for five months or more can expect an official warning letter from Glencannon Homes Association. Failure to respond will result in a letter from the Glencannon Attorney and a \$100 letter drafting fee will be added to the amount owed. Homeowners that force the Attorney file a lien on their property (for lack of payment) will also have those fees added to their account.

Mr. Creighan called the meeting to order at 7:00pm.

The financial reports were distributed for November 2016. The board discussed the details of the AR list, recent foreclosures and payment arrangements. Letters were sent out this week to the residents who have a balance over a certain amount to let them know a lien will be filed for non-payment. In addition, the board will continue to pursue foreclosure on the seriously delinquent properties.

COMMONS

The lights at Hickory Circle have been repaired and the details of the repairs were reviewed. There is one street light on Hunting Creek that needs repaired and will be fixed depending on the weather. The board discussed that leaf collection by the township has ended. The cornstalks were removed and additional Christmas decorations are being put up.

POND MANAGEMENT

The Harshman Group was contacted and the surveys are done and a plan has been drawn up. They are meeting with the Conservation Department on December 15th to go over permit information. The plan will done by the end of December and will be discussed with the board in January.

NEW BUSINESS

The 2017 budget was discussed. Details of the accounts were discussed and some of the amounts were determined. The pond bills were discussed and will be kept on a separate ledger. A draft budget was distributed and the commons maintenance and improvement ideas were discussed.

The board also discussed the property in the community that requires significant maintenance. The homeowner has been notified and a contractor identified. The specific maintenance will be completed in the coming weeks.

Mr. Creighan made a motion for another property to receive notification that overgrown weeds in the front of their property need removed. The notification will inform them they have 30 days to make the improvement or the board will hire a contractor to do the job at their expense. Ms. Manolas seconded the motion. Vote: Mr. Frohnaphel, Jr. – yes, Mr. Sacco – yes, Mrs. Christopher – yes, Mr. Ackerman – yes, Mr. Byer – yes, Mr. Beard – yes.

Mr. Frohnaphel, Jr. made a motion to adjourn at 8:00 pm.
