

A.C.C. Approval

Any Resident planning to change the exterior of their property must obtain approval from the A.C.C. Chairman. North Strabane Township will not issue a building permit to any resident of Glencannon unless they have this approval from the association. Approval must be obtained for decks, doors, windows, sidewalks, patios, sheds, painting, etc.

A \$50 fine may be assessed for failure to submit the ACC form with proper approval.

Selling Your Property?

If you are planning to sell your property you will need a "Resale Certificate" signed by a GHA Board Member and the GHA Secretary. The Resale Certificate is issued when all GHA dues and assessments have been received by GHA resulting in a zero balance owed. The Resale Certificate is required for your home Closing.

As a reminder under Act 180, the Association has ten days to provide the Resale Certificate and other items to the seller. Please contact the GHA Secretary as soon as possible so that your Resale Certificate can be prepared.

There is a fee of \$75 for a Resale Certificate.

Attorney Fee Policy

Residents who fail to pay the monthly \$43 assessment for five months or more can expect an official warning letter from Glencannon Homes Association. Failure to respond will result in a letter from the Glencannon Attorney and a \$100 letter drafting fee will be added to the amount owed. Homeowners that force the Attorney file a lien on their property (for lack of payment) will also have those fees added to their account.

Glencannon Homes Association February 12, 2019 Executive Meeting

Board members present: Terry Creighan – President, Jim Byer, Tony Sacco, John Ackerman and Doug Krantz.

Shawn Beard not present excused.

Mr. Creighan called the meeting to order at 6:30 pm.

The board reviewed and discussed the financial reports.

NEW BUSINESS

The board discussed a policy for the Board Member Eligibility. The board discussed the details of the bylaws in regards to voting policies per household. There was ongoing discussion about two members in one household being on the board at the same time. Mr. Creighan made a motion to enact a policy that only one occupant from any living unit will be eligible to serve on the GHA Board of Directors at one time. Mr. Byer Seconded the motion. Vote: Mr. Krantz – Yes, Mr. Sacco – Yes and Mr. Ackerman – No. Motion passed: 4-1

The board also discussed the signboard at the pond. The plywood on the board will be removed and replaced with another material.

The board also discussed a specific property that needs attention regarding maintenance and appearance. A certified letter will be sent to the homeowner to identify the needed work.

OLD BUSINESS

The board discussed additional notification of the residents who share the dumpster on Hunting Creek and the needed repair of the area around it.

Meeting adjourned at 7:00 pm.

Shawn Beard – not present and excused.

Mr. Creighan called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm.

FINANCIALS

Mr. Byer made a motion to approve the financials that were discussed in the executive meeting. Mr. Krantz seconded the motion. Vote: Mr. Creighan – yes, Mr. Sacco – yes and Mr. Ackerman – yes.

COMMONS

The board discussed the beds in the community and the plan to obtain bids for the maintenance of them. Once all of the bids are obtained, they will be reviewed and voted on.

ACC

There were 2 requests which were approved.

REC

The board discussed the contract with American Pools and the details being discussed before the pool season. The price of pool parties will be reviewed as well.

OLD BUSINESS

The open board positions that can be filled by the board only were discussed:

Townhouse – expires 2020 – No nomination Townhouse – expires 2021 – No nomination

NEW BUSINESS

Nominations for three expiring positions:
Open position – A resident was present and nominated herself for the open position.
Another resident seconded the nomination. The board informed her that she was not eligible for the position since another person in her household is already on the board. The policy was reviewed with her and additional discussion occurred. Another resident submitted a letter in writing to the board secretary nominating herself for the open position. Mr. Krantz seconded the nomination.

Townhouse: Mr. Byer nominated Mr. Creighan for the position and he accepted. A resident nominated another resident for the position and she accepted the nomination as well.

Single Family Home: Mr. Krantz nominated Mr. Byer for the position and he accepted the nomination.

OPEN DISCUSSION

A Landscaper was present and provided a bid proposal for the board for the beds in the community. The details of the work he would like to do was discussed and the official bid will be sent to the office. Additional bids will be gathered.

A resident was present and talked to the board about a stump that needs removed on upper

Hunting Creek Road. This will be discussed with the landscapers.

Another resident was present for an update on the pond project. The board discussed with her that the permits are still in the process.

Another resident was present to discuss a letter she submitted last month for the newsletter and her feelings about the rebuttal from the board. Additional discussion occurred about other concerns she has about the board eligibility policy.

Another resident was present and discussed issues with the pool parking lot and the dumpster. The dumpster is currently locked for the winter and there is no collection. In addition, the board talked about the chain in the lot no longer being used.

Meeting adjourned at 7:40pm.
