

A.C.C. Approval

Any Resident planning to change the exterior of their property must obtain approval from the A.C.C. Chairman. North Strabane Township will not issue a building permit to any resident of Glencannon unless they have this approval from the association. Approval must be obtained for decks, doors, windows, sidewalks, patios, sheds, painting, etc.

A \$50 fine may be assessed for failure to submit the ACC form with proper approval.

Selling Your Property?

If you are planning to sell your property you will need a "Resale Certificate" signed by a GHA Board Member and the GHA Secretary. The Resale Certificate is issued when all GHA dues and assessments have been received by GHA resulting in a zero balance owed. The Resale Certificate is required for your home Closing.

As a reminder under Act 180, the Association has ten days to provide the Resale Certificate and other items to the seller. Please contact the GHA Secretary as soon as possible so that your Resale Certificate can be prepared.

There is a fee of \$75 for a Resale Certificate.

Attorney Fee Policy

Residents who fail to pay the monthly \$43 assessment for five months or more can expect an official warning letter from Glencannon Homes Association. Failure to respond will result in a letter from the Glencannon Attorney and a \$100 letter drafting fee will be added to the amount owed. Homeowners that force the Attorney file a lien on their property (for lack of payment) will also have those fees added to their account.

Electronics Disposal


Due to the PA electronics recycling law, Electronics cannot be disposed with municipal waste. This includes computers, TV's and any components of these devices.

Dog Laws

Please remember that Pennsylvania and the township of North Strabane have laws pertaining to DOGS.

Pennsylvania State Law: All dogs must be under control and may not be allowed to run at large. Dogs are personal property and owners are responsible for damages caused by their dogs. This means that when your dog is not on your property, it must be under direct control of you or a handler. The best way to control your dog is with a leash.

North Strabane Township Ordinance:

It shall be unlawful for the owner of any dog or dogs to allow or permit such dog or dogs to run at large in the township of North Strabane.

We ask that all residents please leash your dog and clean up after them.

WANTED PROJECT MANAGER

Dear Resident,

We are writing to remind all residents of the North Strabane township ordinance, 105 Standards for Storage of Solid Waste, which is inline with the Glencannon Homes Association By-laws. This ordinance **requires** all trash to be stored in trash cans. See below:

North Strabane Township Ordinance 105 Standards for Storage of Solid Waste.

- The storage of all solid waste shall be practiced so as to prevent the attraction, harborage or breeding of insects or rodents and to eliminate conditions harmful to public health or which create safety hazards, odors, unsightliness or public nuisances.
- 2. Any person producing municipal waste shall provide a sufficient number of approved containers to store all waste materials generated during periods between regularly scheduled collections and shall place and store all waste materials therein. Solid containers shall be of capacity not less than seven nor more than 32 gallons and shall be watertight with a close-fitting lid and have handles thereon. Every such container shall be maintained in good condition and shall be replaced by such person or responsible occupant of the premises when the same becomes unsanitary or offensive. No such container or trash bag shall be filled so full that the waste material overflows therefrom. Such waste material that is scattered shall not be gathered up by the hauler but shall be the responsibility of the offending person(s) or responsible occupant of the subject dwelling unit. Rubbish in grocery bags, loose piles, wet boxes or containers in excess of 32 gallons or larger drums shall not be picked up.
- Any person storing municipal waste for collection shall comply with the minimum standards for storage of municipal waste set forth in Title 25, Chapter 285, Subchapter A, or DER regulations for the storage of municipal waste.
- The placement of solid waste for collection earlier than 24 hours prior to normally scheduled pickup time is hereby prohibited.

Glencannon covenants Article VII

(I) No lot shall be used or maintained as a dumping ground for rubbish. Trash, garbage or other waste shall not be kept except in sanitary containers. All incinerators or other equipment for the storage or disposal of such material shall be kept in a clean and sanitary condition.

For the safety of our neighborhood we ask that residents abide by this. The Board reserves the right to issue a fine to residents who do not comply.
