A.C.C. Approval

Any Resident planning to change the exterior of their property must obtain approval from the A.C.C. Chairman. North Strabane Township will not issue a building permit to any resident of Glencannon unless they have this approval from the association. Approval must be obtained for decks, doors, windows, sidewalks, patios, sheds, painting, etc.

A \$50 fine may be assessed for failure to submit the ACC form with proper approval.

Selling Your Property?

If you are planning to sell your property you will need a "Resale Certificate" signed by a GHA Board Member and the GHA Secretary. The Resale Certificate is issued when all GHA dues and assessments have been received by GHA resulting in a zero balance owed. The Resale Certificate is required for your home Closing.

As a reminder under Act 180, the Association has ten days to provide the Resale Certificate and other items to the seller. Please contact the GHA Secretary as soon as possible so that your Resale Certificate can be prepared.

There is a fee of \$75 for a Resale Certificate.

Attorney Fee Policy

Residents who fail to pay the monthly \$43 assessment for five months or more can expect an official warning letter from Glencannon Homes Association. Failure to respond will result in a letter from the Glencannon Attorney and a \$100 letter drafting fee will be added to the amount owed. Homeowners that force the Attorney file a lien on their property (for lack of payment) will also have those fees added to their account.

Glencannon ACC regulations require that GARBAGE CONTAINERS are to be stored indoors or inconspicuously outdoors (not in front of your residence).

Garbage containers should be placed at the curb no earlier than 5:00 p.m. the night before collection day, and must be removed the next day.

The only sign that is permitted on Glencannon properties is a real estate (for sale) sign.

Contractor signs, advertising and political signs are not permitted (at any time).

Mr. Creighan called the meeting to order at 6:30 pm.

FINANCIALS

The board discussed the financial reports. Clarification was provided with the budget consumption. The vote will occur at the regular meeting.

COMMONS

JG Landscaping is finishing the work on the drainage, sidewalk and steps and the final invoice and work was reviewed. The board also discussed the pond inspection reports and the emergency action plan that was done in 2012. The invoices were discussed as well from North Strabane Township as part of the engineering fees.

Cramer Landscaping will be taking care of the tree that is down at playground A.

REC

The pools area is completed and winterized for the year. The parts to repair the grill were purchased as well.

OLD BUSINESS

A particular ACC request was reviewed and issues with the fence that was put up. It is over the height requirement and is made of plywood. The request will be denied and a formal response sent.

NEW BUSINESS

The board discussed a resident request to have

a property maintenance committee and policy to address all of the properties that are in need of improvements or cleaned up. The board discussed a need for a master list of properties to be notified. Several board members will assist in the process. The ACC chair will begin the process.

Two properties were discussed that have been notified multiple times and are still in need of improvement. The board will vote to fine these individuals until the changes are made.

Mr. Creighan called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm.

FINANCIALS

The board discussed the financials from the previous month. Mr. Krantz made a motion to approve the reports and Mrs. Ware seconded the motion. Vote: Mr. Creighan – yes, Mr. Sacco – Yes, Mr. Wheeler – yes and Mr. Ackerman – abstain.

COMMONS

The board discussed that there is a tree down in playground A. The landscapers were notified and will take care of it. The stair and walkway project with JG Landscaping is being finalized this week. In addition, Cramer Landscaping will begin leaf collection in the community.

REC

The pool house has been winterized by Mr. Miele. American Pools also completed the closure process.

ACC

The ACC Chair discussed the submitted requests. He reported that one request was denied and a response is being developed to be send to the resident.

OLD BUSINESS

There is one Townhouse position and the residents present were informed. No one expressed interest.

NEW BUSINESS

The voting locations were discussed and once it is finalized, information will be posted on the bulletin board.

The board discussed resident requests to have the newsletter delivered electronically. The board discussed that the bylaws state they have to be delivered to each home each month. The newsletters are also posted to

the website. However, other options were discussed about people opting out of the delivery which will be discussed in the future.

OPEN DISCUSSION

A resident was present and stated that she wanted to thank the board for the work that was done on the drainage project behind the pool house. She also expressed that the walkway and stairs looks really good and she appreciated all of the work done.

The board also discussed with her the status of the pond and that the permits are being finalized. The work will begin during the next dry season (most likely July-September 2020).

Another resident was present and stated that he would like to thank the landscapers for clearing the area all around the pool and tennis courts. He stated that it is possible to walk the whole way around the area. He also brought up a tree that needs addressed on Pheasant Cove.

Pennsylvania State Law: All dogs must be under control and may not be allowed to run at large. Dogs are personal property and owners are responsible for damages caused by their dogs. This means that when your dog is not on your property, it must be under direct control of you or a handler. The best way to control your dog is with a leash.

North Strabane Township Ordinance:

It shall be unlawful for the owner of any dog or dogs to allow or permit such dog or dogs to run at large in the township of North Strabane.


