# A.C.C. Approval

Any Resident planning to change the exterior of their property must obtain approval from the A.C.C. Chairman. North Strabane Township will not issue a building permit to any resident of Glencannon unless they have this approval from the association. Approval must be obtained for decks, doors, windows, sidewalks, patios, sheds, painting, etc.

A \$50 fine may be assessed for failure to submit the ACC form with proper approval.

#### Selling Your Property?

If you are planning to sell your property you will need a "Resale Certificate" signed by a GHA Board Member and the GHA Secretary. The Resale Certificate is issued when all GHA dues and assessments have been received by GHA resulting in a zero balance owed. The Resale Certificate is required for your home Closing.

As a reminder under Act 180, the Association has ten days to provide the Resale Certificate and other items to the seller. Please contact the GHA Secretary as soon as possible so that your Resale Certificate can be prepared.

There is a fee of \$75 for a Resale Certificate.

#### Attorney Fee Policy

Residents who fail to pay the monthly \$43 assessment for five months or more can expect an official warning letter from Glencannon Homes Association. Failure to respond will result in a letter from the Glencannon Attorney and a \$100 letter drafting fee will be added to the amount owed. Homeowners that force the Attorney file a lien on their property (for lack of payment) will also have those fees added to their account.



# Dog Laws

Please remember that Pennsylvania and the township of North Strabane have laws pertaining to DOGS.

Pennsylvania State Law: All dogs must be under control and may not be allowed to run at large. Dogs are personal property and owners are responsible for damages caused by their dogs. This means that when your dog is not on your property, it must be under direct control of you or a handler. The best way to control your dog is with a leash.

#### **North Strabane Township Ordinance:**

It shall be unlawful for the owner of any dog or dogs to allow or permit such dog or dogs to run at large in the township of North Strabane.

We ask that all residents please clean up after your pets. Thank you for your cooperation.

Glencannon ACC regulations require that GARBAGE CONTAINERS are to be stored indoors or inconspicuously outdoors (not in front of your residence).

Garbage containers should be placed at the curb no earlier than 5:00 p.m. the night before collection day, and must be removed the next day.



#### Glencannon Homes Association Executive Meeting - Minutes October 12, 2021

#### Roll Call

Doug Krantz – President, Shawn Beard – Vice President, Jim Byer, Dave Wheeler and John Ackerman. Gretchen Gregorchik and Terry Creighan was not present and excused.

Mr. Krantz called the meeting to order at 6:30pm

#### Financials

The financial reports that were distributed last week were discussed. The board discussed several properties that have been notified of potential foreclosure. Plans were discussed to address additional delinquent properties.

#### Commons

The board discussed the meeting last month with the realtors about the interest in purchasing a portion of the green space on 19. Mr. Beard made a motion to not pursue this with them any further, Mr. Byer seconded the motion. Vote: Mr. Krantz – yes, Mr. Ackerman – abstain and Mr. Wheeler – abstain.

The landscaping contract was discussed and the status of the bids. Mr. Beard made a motion to accept the bid from Cramer with additional changes and expectations to the contract for a total of \$42,500. Mr. Byer seconded the motion. Vote: Mr. Ackerman – yes, Mr. Wheeler – yes and Mr. Krantz – yes.

The Board discussed replacing three lights and adding one more on Hunting Creek. It was decided to table this discussion until it is decided what is to be done with the pond lights. A Board Member is looking into our options regarding the light that is on the ground. We will also be contacting the Contractor to get an estimate on when the part for Hickory Circle should be in stock.

The board also talked about several properties that were notified of repairs or improvements needed. The status of what was done and not done was discussed and additional notification of ACC fines.

#### **New Business**

Finding a meeting location for the winter months was discussed and the multiple places that were contacted with no success. The board discussed providing finalized details in the upcoming newsletters.

Mr.Krantz made a motion to adjourn at 7pm and Mr. Beard seconded the motion. Vote: Mr. Wheeler – yes, Mr. Byer – yes and Mr. Ackerman – yes.



#### Glencannon Homes Association Monthly Meeting of the Directors October 12, 2021

Mr. Krantz called the meeting to order at 7:00pm.

#### Roll Call

Doug Krantz – President, Shawn Beard – Vice President, Jim Byer, Dave Wheeler and John Ackerman. Terry Creighan and Gretchen Gregorchik not present and excused.

#### Financials

Mr. Byer made a motion to approve the financials. Mr. Beard seconded the motion. Vote: Mr. Ackerman– yes, Mr. Krantz – yes and Mr. Wheeler – yes.

#### Commons

The renewal of the landscaping contract with Cramer was discussed. In addition, The tree work is nearly completed by Cherrytree. They will return when equipment is repaired as their schedule allows. The update on the lights on Hunting Creek and Hickory Circle was provided.

The update on Playground A was provided: The equipment is being removed and a scrap dealer will be taking the metal pieces this Wednesday. The plastic pieces will be disposed of in the pool dumpster and the contractors may have some room in their own dumpster they are using for the concrete being removed. Additional pricing details were discussed as well.

#### Rec

A report was provided: the pool has been painted and will be winterized by American Pool in the coming weeks. The pool will have to be re-filled to halfway, but there should be minimal algae in the spring, so the water will be useable. Once all the pool winterizing is done, the building will be winterized. The new baby pool surface requires water to be in the pool over the winter, purchasing a safety cover (like the main pool) will be considered. A new medium duty tarp for the slide is needed as well. We had a few closures at the end of pool season due to lack of staffing, but overall, our lifeguards did a good job this year. ACC

Three requests were submitted and approved.

#### **Old Business**

The open board positions were discussed. The four residents present were not interested.

#### Open Discussion

A resident was present to discuss issues with a fence on a neighboring property that he believes is over the height requirement. The board agreed to look at it and notify the homeowner.

Another resident was present and discussed the interest in purchasing the common space on 19. She expressed her concerns and that she does not feel it should be a consideration due to environmental issues that would occur. The board discussed that the decision to sell property is a community vote and they could not sell property. They did get the information and voted at the executive meeting to not go any further in the process.

Mr. Byer motioned to adjourn at 7:30pm and Mr. Beard seconded the motion. Vote: Mr. Ackerman—yes, Mr. Krantz — yes and Mr. Wheeler — yes.

What is the process for ordering a resale packet?

The packet has to be sent to the buyer at least five days prior to closing. We cannot accommodate rush requests or in-person payments.
