A.C.C. Approval

Any Resident planning to change the exterior of their property must obtain approval from the A.C.C. Chairman. North Strabane Township will not issue a building permit to any resident of Glencannon unless they have this approval from the association. Approval must be obtained for decks, doors, windows, sidewalks, patios, sheds, painting, etc.

A \$50 fine may be assessed for failure to submit the ACC form with proper approval.

Selling Your Property?

If you are planning to sell your property you will need a "Resale Certificate" signed by a GHA Board Member and the GHA Secretary. The Resale Certificate is issued when all GHA dues and assessments have been received by GHA resulting in a zero balance owed. The Resale Certificate is required for your home Closing.

As a reminder under Act 180, the Association has ten days to provide the Resale Certificate and other items to the seller. Please contact the GHA Secretary as soon as possible so that your Resale Certificate can be prepared.

There is a fee of \$75 for a Resale Certificate.

Attorney Fee Policy

Residents who fail to pay the monthly \$43 assessment for five months or more can expect an official warning letter from Glencannon Homes Association. Failure to respond will result in a letter from the Glencannon Attorney and a \$100 letter drafting fee will be added to the amount owed. Homeowners that force the Attorney file a lien on their property (for lack of payment) will also have those fees added to their account.

My father was chased by two large dogs, can you elaborate on dog owner responsibilities and the possible legal issues?

Plain and simple, if you see a large dog loose and running free (even if it's well away from you), call the police because someone can be injured.

Those with aggressive dogs are 100% responsible for the actions and damage caused by the dog(s).

We've had an increased number of reported incidents and some of those cases have ended up in court with hefty fines and awarded damages to the people harmed.

Leaf Collection in North Strabane starts October 21st and continues on Wednesdays through the end of November. The collection day is affected by weather and may vary from week to week.

Once he is done with Pittsburgh Paints, he will then move on to Sherwin Williams paint colors. A second person will verify these colors as well. He also revised the wording on the ACC guidelines. The board discussed the issues with door colors on multiple streets and people that need to have their houses painted.

NEW BUSINESS

A member of the board discussed that the voting precincts were separated. He let everyone know

Reminder!

Glencannon ACC regulations require that GARBAGE CONTAINERS are to be stored indoors or inconspicuously outdoors (not in front of your residence).

Garbage containers should be placed at the curb **no earlier than 5:00 p.m. the night before collection day,** and should be removed the next day.

Dog Laws

Please remember that Pennsylvania and the township of North Strabane have laws pertaining to DOGS.

Pennsylvania State Law: All dogs must be under control and may not be allowed to run at large. Dogs are personal property and owners are responsible for damages caused by their dogs. This means that when your dog is not on your property, it must be under direct control of you or a handler. The best way to control your dog is with a leash.

North Strabane Township Ordinance:

It shall be unlawful for the owner of any dog or dogs to allow or permit such dog or dogs to run at large in the township of North Strabane.

> We ask that all residents please clean up after your pets. Thank you for your cooperation.

Top 5 reasons to have your dog on a leash

1. Setting a good example :

If someone sees your well behaved dog off a leash in the neighborhood, they may think it's okay for their dog too; inappropriately trained dogs running loose aren't good for anyone. As good pet owners we should keep our dogs under constant control.

2. Protecting your dog :

Some people just don't know how to read a dog's body language; they may mace your dog in the face in an attempt to protect themselves. The leash is there to protect your dog from the world as much as it's there to protect the world from your dog.

3. Liability :

You are liable for your dog's actions. Bad things can happen if your dog is running loose. A court may feel letting your dog off leash shows a reckless lack of concern for those around you. If something goes wrong, you could find yourself in a lot of hot water.

4 . Irresistible , Unpredictable Temptations :

You might take your dog off leash 1,000 times without a problem and you can't predict which temptation might be their undoing.

5 . IT'S THE LAW TO HAVE YOUR DOG UNDER CONTROL AT ALL TIMES :

Leash-less slackers meet Dog Catchers. Breaking this law might not seem like a big deal until you have to explain why an animal control or a police car is sitting in front of your house.

<u>Glencannon Pond Repairs – Project Status Update</u>

Permit Applications:

- a) Township Grading Permit We have received comments back from the Township regarding the grading permit. Most of the comments have been addressed already, but North Strabane does want us to camera the existing pipes for the primary spillway and the emergency spillway and provide the video to show that the existing pipes are not in need of repairs. As approved by the board, a contractor has been contacted to aid the pipe cleaning company in accessing the spillway to camera the line. We are currently waiting for them to get back to us to set up a date for the work to be completed.
- **b)** Joint Permit Application –Pending DEP review.
- c) NPDES (National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System) Permit DEP is requesting a stormwater consistency letter from the Township. We will be obtaining this upon completion of the Township's review of the grading permit and the video inspections of the primary spillway pipe.
- d) Chapter 105 Dam Amendment/Authorization Letter & Dam Permit DEP Comments recently received for the dam permit will be addressed. One of the more notable comments asks for a revised Emergency Action Plan (EAP), stating that the EAP should be revised every 5 years and the last revision on record is from 2011. If the board has an updated EAP, please send us a copy to be submitted to DEP. If not, then we could prepare one should the board desire us to. Additionally, DEP has asked for a copy of the O&M Plan for the dam as well. Please send us a copy if possible.
- e) General Permit 7 (GP-7) Approved by WCCD.

Miscellaneous:

a.) The GHA board has voted to proceed with this work during the first dry season (July - October) as soon as all of the permits and bids are finished.
