

A.C.C. Approval

Any Resident planning to change the exterior of their property must obtain approval from the A.C.C. Chairman. North Strabane Township will not issue a building permit to any resident of Glencannon unless they have this approval from the association. Approval must be obtained for decks, doors, windows, sidewalks, patios, sheds, painting, etc.

A \$50 fine may be assessed for failure to submit the ACC form with proper approval.

Selling Your Property?

If you are planning to sell your property you will need a "Resale Certificate" signed by a GHA Board Member and the GHA Secretary. The Resale Certificate is issued when all GHA dues and assessments have been received by GHA resulting in a zero balance owed. The Resale Certificate is required for your home Closing.

As a reminder under Act 180, the Association has ten days to provide the Resale Certificate and other items to the seller. Please contact the GHA Secretary as soon as possible so that your Resale Certificate can be prepared.

There is a fee of \$75 for a Resale Certificate.

Attorney Fee Policy

Residents who fail to pay the monthly \$43 assessment for five months or more can expect an official warning letter from Glencannon Homes Association. Failure to respond will result in a letter from the Glencannon Attorney and a \$100 letter drafting fee will be added to the amount owed. Homeowners that force the Attorney file a lien on their property (for lack of payment) will also have those fees added to their account.



Dog Laws

Please remember that Pennsylvania and the township of North Strabane have laws pertaining to DOGS.

Pennsylvania State Law: All dogs must be under control and may not be allowed to run at large. Dogs are personal property and owners are responsible for damages caused by their dogs. This means that when your dog is not on your property, it must be under direct control of you or a handler. The best way to control your dog is with a leash.

North Strabane Township Ordinance:

It shall be unlawful for the owner of any dog or dogs to allow or permit such dog or dogs to run at large in the township of North Strabane.

We ask that all residents please clean up after your pets. Thank you for your cooperation.

Glencannon ACC regulations require that GARBAGE CONTAINERS are to be stored indoors or inconspicuously outdoors (not in front of your residence).

Garbage containers should be placed at the curb no earlier than 5:00 p.m. the night before collection day, and must be removed the next day.



Glencannon Homes Association Monthly Meeting of the Directors - Minutes September 14, 2021

Roll Call

Doug Krantz – President, Shawn Beard – Vice President, Jim Byer, Gretchen Gregorchik and Terry Creighan. Dave Wheeler arrived at 6:45pm and John Ackerman was not present and excused.

Mr. Krantz called the meeting to order at 6:29pm

Andrew McIlvaine, President and Adam Lazenga, Finance and Real Estate Manager from Coen Markets, Inc and Kevin Riley, President of Totum Realty Advisors were present and gave a presentation on their interest in purchasing and developing the green space along 19 that is owned by Glencannon. Mr. McIlvaine provided an overview of Coen Markets Inc and their current goals. Mr. Lazenga discussed their current ownership of the property on the corner of 19 and McClelland and their interest in purchasing a ½ acre of green space as a buffer for the building on their current space. He provided a visual plan for development. The board discussed with them the impact of noise and light pollution as well as traffic in that area. The board also notified them that the sale of common area is a community decision and not solely from the board. They are in the beginning stages of planning and will provide additional information at a later time.

Financials

The financial reports that were distributed last week were discussed. The AR list was also discussed and the status of unpaid properties in regard to lien and foreclosure. The budget consumption was also discussed.

Commons

The landscaping contract was discussed, and three bids are being obtained. The potential separation of the contract was discussed between landscaping and snow removal. The board also discussed the vote that occurred over the last few weeks and the decision made for the earth and berm at the pond.

The board discussed the light post that is down on Village. The bottom of it is corroded and needs remodified before it is put back in. The photo sensor with the poles needs repaired as well. An electrician was contacted to address these issues.

The board discussed the field behind Hunting Creek and possible issues with water runoff. Research is needed for the specifics of the issue.

The culvert area of the pond was discussed, and a tree and other items were removed today.

The garbage can at playground A was discussed and will need replaced. Specifics were discussed in regard to design and price.

Mr. Beard make a motion to adjourn the meeting at 7:10pm, Mrs. Gregorchik seconded the motion. Vote: Mr. Krantz – yes, Mr. Byer – yes, Mr. Wheeler – yes.

Financials

Mr. Byer made a motion to approve the financials. Mr. Creighan seconded the motion. Vote: Mr. Beard – yes, Mr. Krantz – yes, Mrs. Gregorchik – yes and Mr. Wheeler – yes.

Commons

The grass cutting was discussed and additional areas that need done.

Rec

The pool is closed for the season and is currently being drained to the halfway point. The painting of the pool will start in October. American pools will winterize after the painting is completed.

ACC

Two requests were submitted and approved.

Old Business

The open board positions were discussed. The one resident present was not interested.

Open Discussion

A resident was present to discuss the paving project on Meadowview which is close to being a signed contract. Additional costs are being reviewed as well for the subbase.

Mr. Byer motioned to adjourn at 7:30pm and Mr. Creighan seconded the motion. Vote: Mrs. Gregorchik – yes, Mr. Krantz – yes and Mr. Wheeler – yes and Mr. Beard – yes.

Questions of the month from residents:

What do I do about my neighbors cat that is on my property?

There seems to be several cats in the neighborhood that are rooming around and going into other people yards, porches etc. The consistent issues that are brought up are cats using mulch beds for litter boxes and bringing dead rodents onto neighboring properties. This is a neighbor issue. If you have this concern please discuss it with your neighbor. If you have an outdoor cat, please be mindful of this. What is the status of the lights that need repaired in the community?

Please be advised that repairs take time to schedule, order, and take place. While this has always been the case, the Pandemic has exacerbated the problem in a number of functional areas. This is also the case with the lights that are out on Hickory Circle as we are waiting on parts that are on backorder. We are working on this.

How did the cluster mailbox get fixed on Meadowview?

A resident paid \$260 to have the mailbox fixed. If you use the mailbox and would like to contribute to the cost, please email the office.

What do I do if my neighbors are loud?

The North Strabane noise ordinance starts at 10pm. While we understand that this can be frustrating to deal with, it is a neighbor issue, one that a homeowners association has limited authority to deal with. Please call the police at 724.746.8474.
